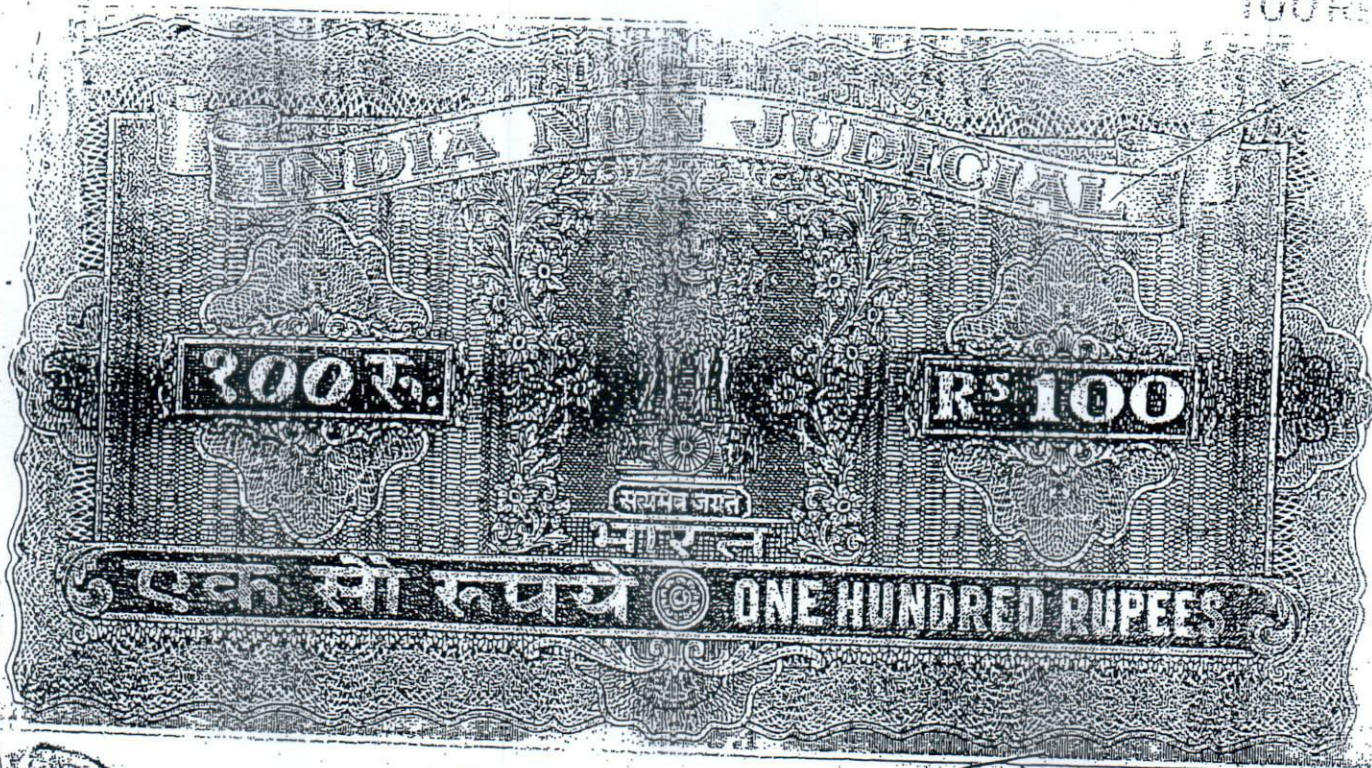

I. DECLARATION OF TRUST:

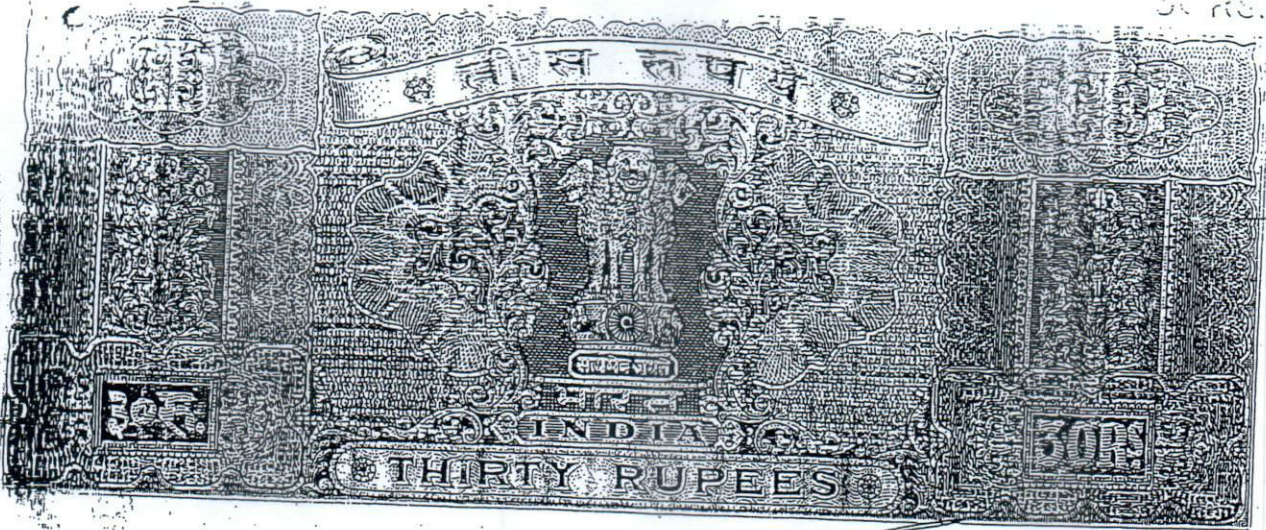

IV. OFFICE OF THE TRUST.

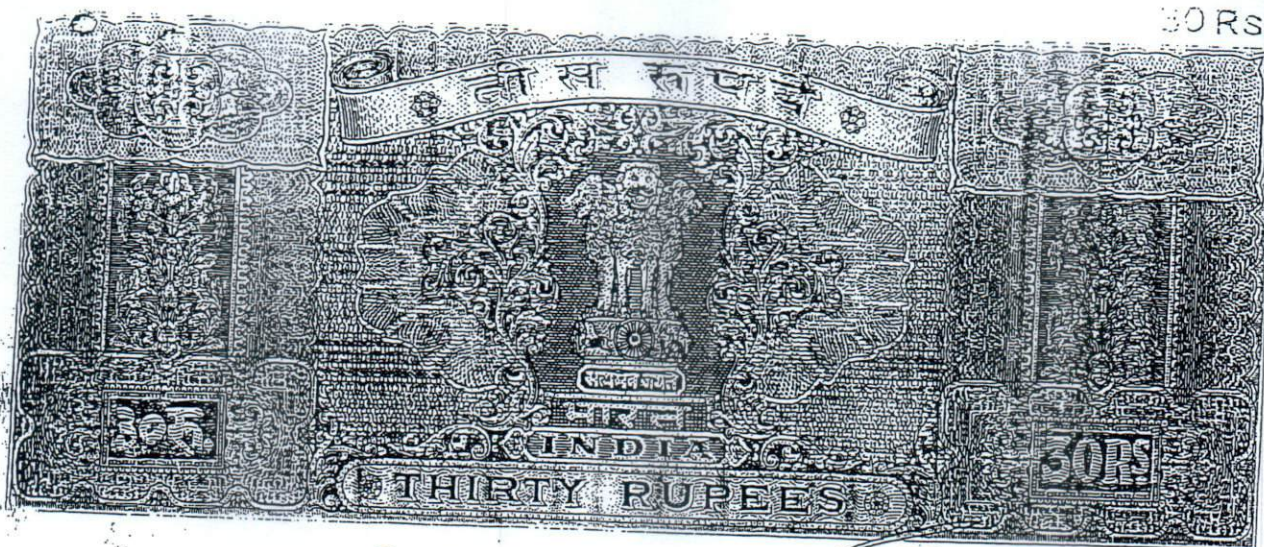

To establish, maintain, run, manage, take over, acquire, improve, extend, up-grade or donate, aid and assist in the establishment, maintenance, development, improvement of Institutions to impart Knowledge and/or Training, with or without any affiliation to any recognised University through proper establishment of Colleges, Schools, Institutions, Workshop etc.,
2. To acquire by purchase, gift or otherwise, lands house-sites and buildings; to erect, build and construct or to aid and assist in the erection, construction and building of houses, buildings for educational institutions and colleges, libraries, staff quarters hostels, and/or any other type of building or, construction whatsoever and to maintain or run them, and if necessary to alter, demolish or reconstruct them or any portion or portions thereof as may from time to time be necessary expedient.
3. To acquire and take over all or any part of the immovable or movable properties of any person, society, trust

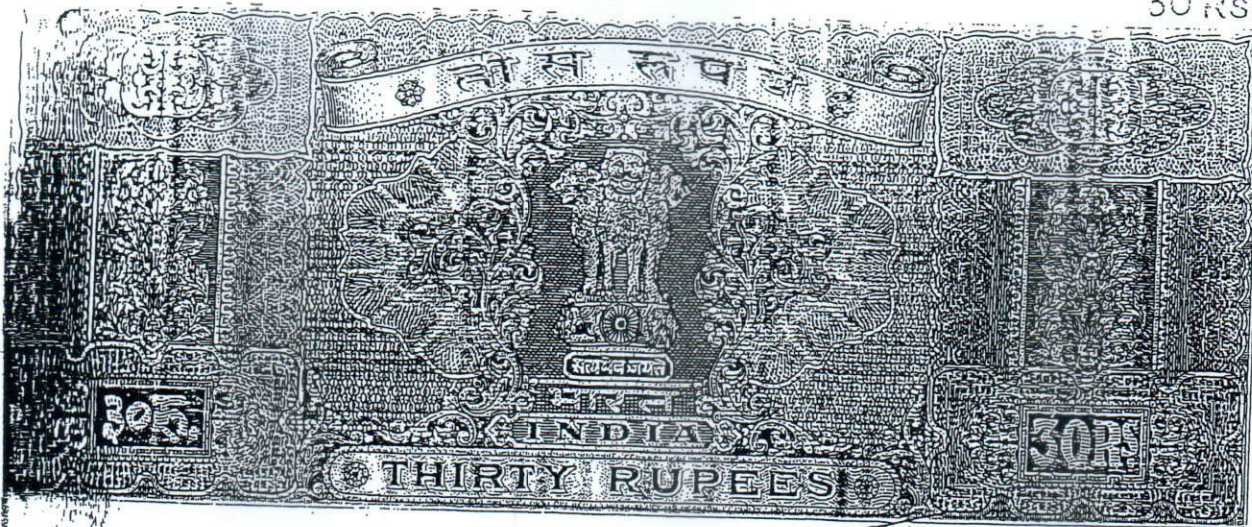

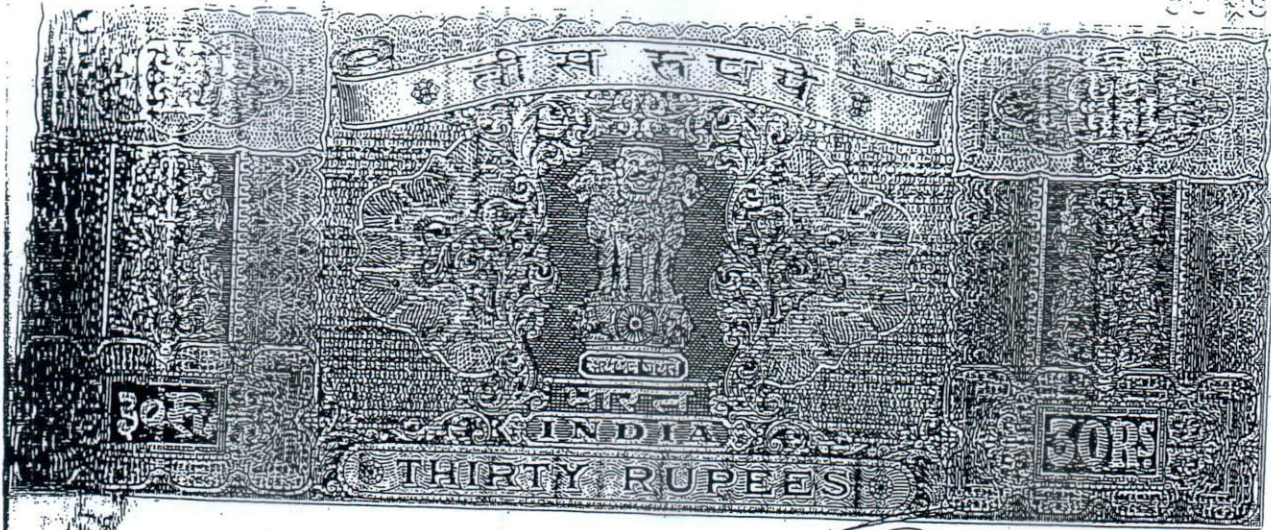

10. To raise and borrow money and secure the payment of money by such means upon such terms and conditions and in such manner as may be determined. To collect manage and disburse the funds raised or to be raised for all or any of the objects of the Trust. To do and cause to be done all such lawful things as are in accord with the spirit and principles of the objects of the trust or which are conducive to the objects of the Trust or which are conducive to the attainment, and pursuit of the aims and objects of the Trust.

12. To open, found, establish, promote, set-up, run, maintain, assist, finance, support or aid or help in the setting up and or running hospitals, charitable dispensaries, maternity homes, child welfare centres, convalescent homes, sanatoriums, hostels and other similar institutions or centres for rendering or providing medical relief and or aid to the suffering humanities or for research centres and institutions for promotion of research and education for medical science including surgery.
13. To open, found, establish, promote, set-up, run, maintain, assist, finance and/or aid or help in the setting up and or maintaining and/or running by monetary gifts or otherwise, centres, stadium, play-grounds, auditorium and parks for public use sports and games and other social welfare works and/or activities in India or abroad.
14. To promote, organise, administer, establish support, maintain and/or grant aid to any person, institution or Society or organisation whatsoever having for its objects of charitable

To promote, assist and/or maintain all activities by whosoever carried on or wherever carried on in India in conformity with the objects of the Trust and as are conducive to the well being and general welfare of the nation or are conducive for advancement of any object or objects of general public utility not involving/carrying on any activity for profit.

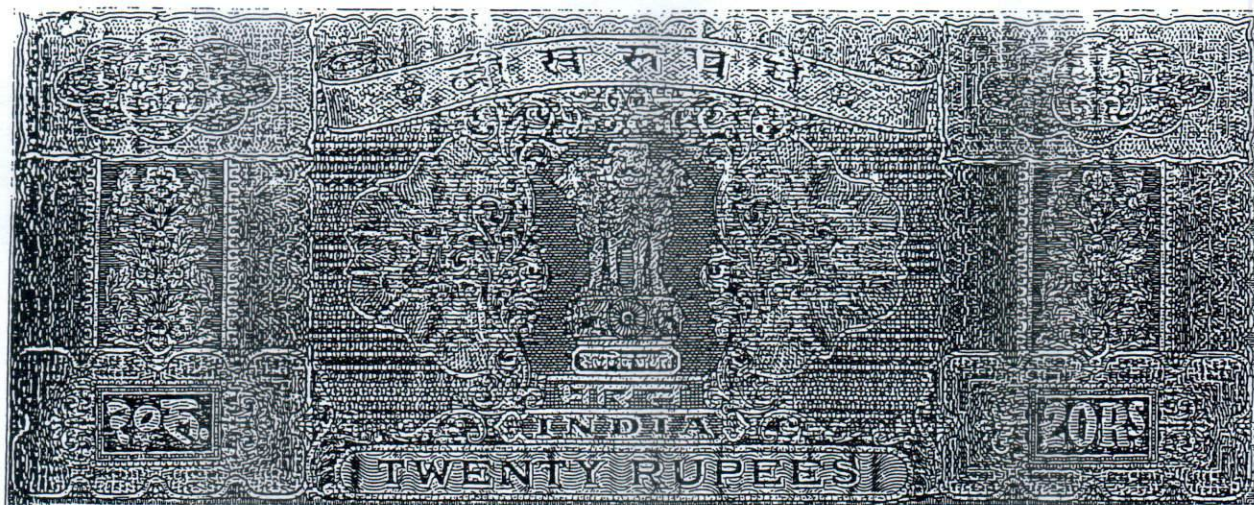
17. And gnerally to do and causeto be doneall such lawful things as may be required for all or anyof the above objectsfrom time to time.

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VI. TRUST FUND:

a) The sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) declared by the Author of the TRUST form part of the corpus of the TRUST.

b) The proceeds of donations/grants received from the public shall be credited to the TRUST fund.

c) The income of the properties of the TRUST to be purchased and sale proceeds of any property of the TRUST sold and income form the permitted activity if any, shall be credited to the TRUST fund.

d) The TRUST shall invest in such manner as would comply with the various enactments governing investment of funds by educational institutions and charitable Trusts.

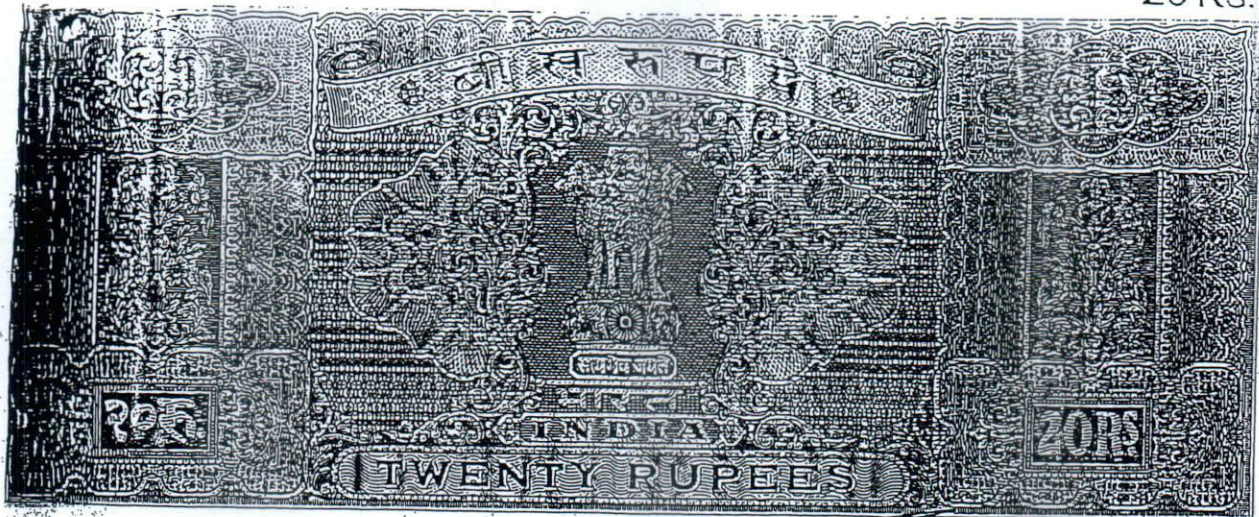
VII. MANAGEMENT OF THE TRUST:

4. Mrs.J.Kasthuri, Wife of Mr.B.Jayachandran, aged about 41 years, residing at 24, Chengalvarayan Street, Shenoy Nagar, Madras-600030, as the Sub-Treasurer of the Trust.

The Author of the Trust, Mr.D.Sudarsanam, shall be the Managing Trustee and Treasurer for Life and after him, one of his legal heirs, as nominated by him shall be the Managing Trustee and Treasurer for life, and in the absence of such nomination one of the legal heirs, of the Author as desired by majority of the Trustees for the time being of the Trust shall be the

#### VIII. BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

1. There shall benotless thantwo trustees andnot more than seven Trustees in the Board of Trustees;
2. Only the following person could be elected asTrustees:
  - a. The minimum ageof the Trustees shall be 18 (Eighteen) years.
  - b) He should bea Person of sound mind.
  - c) He should not be an undischarged insolvent.
3. The Board of Trustees so appointed by the Author shall hold such respective office for life, aftertheir death or resignation, their respective nominated legal heirs as may be decided by majority of the Trustees, as the casemaybe, shall hold such officefor his/their life and so on so forth. In the case of anyvacancy falling, owing to such nominated legal heir or such of the legal heir as decided by majority of the Trustees, to succeed the deceased Trustee, as the case may be, declining to accept the trusteeship, or otherwise, as the case maybe, in any of the Offices, the Managing Trustee for

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the time of the Trust shall appoint any other person or Trustee to such Office, and the decision of the managing trustee shall be final and such decisions shall not be called into question.

2. Mr.D.Dasarathan, Son of R.Dharma Naidu, aged about 43 years, residing at 24, Chengalvarayan Street, Shenoy Nagar, Madras-30, as vice Chairman and Treasurer of the Trust.
3. Mr.D.Duraisamy, Son of R.Dharma Naidu, aged about 47 years, residing at 24, Chengalvarayan Street, Shenoy Nagar, Madras-30, as the Secretary of the Trust.
4. Mr.D.Paranthaman Son of R.Dharma Naidu, aged about 45 years, residing at 24, Chengalvarayan Street, Shenoy Nagar, Madras-30, as the Joint-Secretary and Public Relations Officer of the Trust.
5. Mrs.J.Kasthuri, Wife of Mr.B.Jayachandran, aged about 41 years, residing at 24, Chengalvarayan Street, Shenoy Nagar, Madras-30, as the Su-Treasurer of the Trust.

IX.REMOVAL OF TRUSTEES:

The Trustee can be removed from his office as Trustee if:

- a) He becomes a person of unsound mind.
- b) He declared as an insolvent and remains undischarged as such.

e) If he acts in such a manner that detrimental to the TRUST.

d) By resolution of not less than 2/3rd of the Trustees.

f) If the Trustee fails to attend three consecutive meetings of the Board of Trustees without leave of absence, from the Managing Trustee. In all the cases the Managing Trustee is the sole authority to decide on the desirability of such disqualification and his decision shall not be called into question.

#### X. REQUIREMENT TO HOLD A GENERAL BODY MEETING:

1. The TRUST shall hold its Annual General Meeting within 18 months from the date of declaration of the TRUST. It must be held in addition to any other General Meeting.

2. Subsequent Annual General Meeting must be held in each year within 6 months after the close of financial year but the interval between any two Annual General Meeting must not be more than 18 months.

3. The Annual General meeting must be called on a working day during business hours either at Registered Office (or) at some other place within the city in which the Registered Office is situated.

4. At least 21 days written notice is required to call on Annual General Meeting. Annual General Meeting may be held with a shorter notice not less than 7 days if desired by the Board of Trustees.

5. The Quorum for the General Body Meeting shall be 1/3rd of the total number of Trustees for the time being on the date of notice to the meeting or 4 members physically present, whichever is less. If the Quorum is not present, the meeting may be deferred by half an hour and reconvened. Quorum is not necessary for the adjourned meeting.

6. The Trustee can appoint proxies to represent himself in the Annual General Body and Extra-ordinary General Body.

Meetings. Such proxies will have right of voting on a resolution. But they shall not participate in any discussions in the meeting.

The following business shall be transacted in the general body meeting.

1. Adoption of accounts and auditor's report.
2. Appointment of auditors.
3. Any other business that the board of Trustees deem fit.

4. In all general meetings the managing Trustee shall be the chairman of the meeting. In his absence Vice-President shall be the chairman of the meeting. If both of them are not present the secretary shall act as the Chairman. If all of them are not present the General Body can elect the chairman. The chairman of the meeting shall have a casting vote in the event of any tie on any resolution.

#### XI. CALLING OF EXTRA-ORDINARY GENERAL MEETING:

Extra-ordinary general meeting of the TRUST can be held in the following instances.

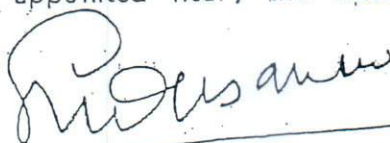
1. By resolution of the Board of Trustees

2. Upon request from at least 1/3rd of the total number of Trustees as on the date of such requisition and the meeting shall be called within 30 days of receipt of requisition.

3. The notice calling for the extraordinary general body meeting shall specify the purpose for which the meeting was called for, the names and addresses of Trustee/Trustees at whose instance the meeting is called for besides the date and place of such meeting.

4. 21 days notice shall be given in respect of such extraordinary general body meeting.

5. The Quorum for such extra-ordinary meeting shall be the same as that of general body meeting. If no quorum is present at the appointed hour, the meeting shall be adjourned

  
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by half an hour and reconvened. Quorum is not necessary for the adjourned meeting.

6. The Trustee/member can appoint proxy to represent himself in the Annual General Body and Extra-Ordinary General Body Meeting. Such proxies will have the right of voting on a resolution. But they shall not participate in any discussions in the meeting.

#### XII. RIGHTS OF TRUSTEES.

1. Those persons who are admitted as Trustee shall constitute the general body of the TRUST and shall have the following rights and privileges.

2. The trustees shall be entitled to attend and vote in the Annual General Meeting of the TRUST for the election of Trustee and for the passing of any resolution required to be passed by the General Body Meeting.

3. Each member is entitled to receive notice of General Body Meeting of which he is a member and to move any resolutions and to vote on any resolutions thereat.

4. The Trusteeship is not transferable except by way of succession to the nominees as stipulated above.

#### XIII. PROCEEDINGS OF THE TRUST:

1. The Board of Trustees shall meet at least once in Six Months with a clear notice of seven days caused by the secretary or the Managing Trustee of the TRUST.

2. The Trustees may meet together for the deciding on day today effective functioning of the TRUST and regulate their proceedings.

3. The Managing Trustee of the Board shall preside over all the Meetings of the Board of Trustees during the term of his office. If any chance, he could not attend the meeting, the Trustees present shall elect one amongst them to preside over the meetings.





XIV. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE MANAGING TRUSTEE:

a) The Managing Trustee shall be empowered to: appoint any person for any office or job or Office of Agents, Legal Advisors, Accountants and others at such remuneration as the Managing Trustee may deem fit.

c) Advisory Committee for important matters as may be deem fit by the Managing Trustee from time to time.

2. To invest the TRUST funds in such securities and investments as may be decided by the Managing Trustee, in accordance with legal provisions as prevalent from time to time and as applicable to educational institutions and in particular in compliance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act.

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3. To buy or take on lease immovable properties for the TRUST and or put up building or structures of land belonging to or under the control or possession of the TRUST.
4. To sell or otherwise dispose of any immovable property.
5. To let any portion of immovable property forming part of the TRUST fund on such terms and conditions as he may think fit and further to accept surrender of any lease.
6. To open maintain, or operate bank accounts in name of the TRUST and to make the accounts operatable in such manner as he may decide from time to time.
7. To institute, conduct, defend compound or abandon any legal proceedings by or against the TRUST or Trustees, and allow time and indulgence for payment or satisfaction of any debt dues or any claim or demand by or against the TRUST. The TRUST shall be represented by the Managing Trustee or at the option of the Managing Trustee by any other Trustee, in all proceedings.
8. To delegate any power as he deems fit from time to time to any person and to execute such power of attorney as he may think fit for the purpose.
9. To withdraw any power or revoke any appointment of any employees or attorney, or person whosoever.
10. To borrow monies for the purposes of the TRUST on such terms and conditions as may be decided from time to time and to authorise any one or more of the Trustees to execute such documents including the deeds of mortgage, charge, of hypothecation as may be necessary for the said purpose and also to create any mortgage or charge on any of the TRUST properties movable or immovable for the said purpose.
11. To Amend any part of this Deed for the effective management of the trust.

XV. ACCOUNTS & AUDIT:

The TRUST shall maintain regular accounts of all its transactions showing clearly the receipts and expenditure. All the expenses of the TRUST shall be properly vouched and audited by a Chartered Accountant every year. The Accounts of the TRUST shall be approved by the Board of Trustees and General Body every year.

XVI. STATUTORY OBLIGATIONS:

a) The Trustees shall comply with all the relevant statutory obligations.

b) The TRUST shall invest the TRUST funds in such forms and in such securities as are permitted by the law governing investment of funds by Educational Institutions. No investment shall be made by the TRUST which shall render it ineligible for exemption under provisions of the Income Tax Act in respect of donations received by it or in respect of income earned by it.

XVII. INDEMNITY:

The Trustees shall at all times stand indemnified in respect of any act they have made bonafide, committed or omitted to be done in respect of matters relating to the TRUST.

XVIII. GENERAL:

1. The Author of the TRUST hereby declares that this declaration of TRUST shall be irrevocable.

2. The income from the TRUST after meeting out the expenses shall always be used and applied for, for the furtherance of their objectives and purpose mentioned and specified herein above.

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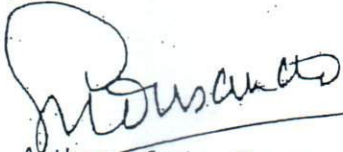
