SCHOOL EMBLEM

A symbol of continuous progress leading towards peaks of prosperity and success with sanctity and glow.

SRI CHAKRA

The Sri Yantra (“sacred instrument”) or Sri Chakra (“sacred wheel”) or Mahameru (3D) is Yantra formed by nine interlocking triangle that surround and radiate out from the central (bindu) point, the junction point between the physical universe and its unmanifest source. It represents the goddess in her form of Shrilalita or Tripura Sundari.

THE WORSHIP

The worship of the Sri Chakra is central to the Shrividya system of Hindu worship. Four isosceles triangles with the apices upwards, representing Shiva or the Masculine. Five isosceles triangles with the apices downward, symbolizing female embodiment Shakti.

THE NINE TRIANGLES

These nine triangles are of various sizes and intersect with one another. In the middle is the power point (bindu), symbolizing the highest, the invisible, elusive center from which the entire figure and the cosmos expand. The triangles are enclosed by two rows of (8 and 16) petals, representing the lotus of creation and reproductive vital force. The broken lines of the outer frame denote the figure to be a sanctum with four openings to the regions of the universe”.

THE NAV CHAKRA

The Shri Chakra is also known as the nav chakra because it can also be seen as having nine levels. “Nine” comes from “Nav or Nava” of Sanskrit. Each level corresponds to a mudra, a yogini, and a specific form of the deity Tripura Sundari along with her mantra.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE :

1. The school admits both boys and girls, subject to the availability of seats irrespective of caste, creed, community or social status.
2. A student seeking admission can obtain the application form from the school office.
3. When applying for admission, Photocopies of the following documents must be submitted :
 - 1) Birth Certificate (In English only)
 - 2) Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate with endorsement
 - 3) Report Card
 - 4) Community Certificate(BC/MBC/SC/ST)
 - 5) Aadhaar Card (Photo Copy)
 - 6) Address Proof
 - 7) Online Registration Number (If applicable)
 - 8) EMIS Number
 - 9) UDISE (Unified District Information System for Education).
4. The School Management reserves the right to reject any application without assigning any reason.

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE / FEE PAYMENT

LEAVE LETTER :

Format of the leave letter is printed in the handbook. Parents are requested to take photocopies, sign and return while applying for leave.

The following rules should be adhered to while applying for leave.

- a) The class teacher should be intimated before taking leave.
- b) 90% Attendance is required for an Academic year.
- c) Leave should be sanctioned in advance, except in cases of sickness.
- d) A leave letter with a medical certificate must be submitted when the child returns to school after recovering from illness.
- e) Long leave for pilgrimage, religious function or marriage is not permitted.
- f) Attendance is compulsory on all re-opening days and closing days of the sessions.
- g) Whenever leave is taken, parents must maintain a leave record for the student, indicating the total leaves taken in the academic year, the number of leaves taken in that particular month, and a valid reason for condonation of attendance shortage.
- h) Students with a shortage of attendance cannot be recommended for the CBSE Board Examination.

FEE :

- a) School fees must be paid on or before the prescribed date to avoid additional late fees.
- b) A delay in fee payment is liable to a fine of Rs. 200, which will increase progressively every 10 days.
- c) Arrears of fees for more than 45 days will render the name of the student liable to be removed from the roll.
- d) Fees must not be sent with students under any circumstances.
- e) Parents are solely responsible for paying the fees, as they have admitted their ward, who is receiving services from the school.
- f) The due dates for Term I fees are 5th April and for Term II fees are 16th September of the concerned Academic year.
- g) These dates apply to both tuition and transport fees.
- h) Parents should not expect continuous reminders or indefinite extensions of fee payment dates.

Note : The last date to apply for a TC will be communicated through a circular in January. In case of applying TC after the intimated last date, parents must pay the Term I Fee of that particular Academic year.

If a TC is applied for after the second week of September, parents must clear both Term I and Term II fees to obtain the TC.

SCHOOL POLICY AND GUIDELINES

PARENTS' / GUARDIANS' RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Please read the Handbook and familiarize yourself with the values, rules and regulations of the school.
2. Kindly take responsibility and be aware of your ward's progress in school. Ensure that your ward reviews school assignments at home on a regular basis. Parents are welcome to meet the teachers to discuss matters during allotted time slots.
3. Students should be advised about the section shuffling which is a part of their life process to learn acquiescence and new peer group. All class sections are aligned impartially and equally. Parents are requested not to approach the school to change the section which will disturb the proceedings of the school.
4. Open days are organized as per the dates mentioned in the school calendar. Only parents / guardians should meet teachers, sign and take note of the Achievement Record and feedback from teachers. Tuition teachers or other relatives will not be entertained.
5. If, for any compelling reason, parents are unable to attend 'Open Day,' they should sign the Report Card within the next five days by meeting the class teacher after class hours with a prior appointment.

6. As the medium of instruction in the school is English, your ward will benefit if encouraged to speak in English at home.
7. Holidays declared by the State or Central Government due to inclement weather, strikes, or mourning, as notified by the media, will apply to our school. Parents are requested to avoid phone calls in this regard for further clarification.
8. In the events of closure of the school in extraordinary circumstance, the school may have to work on one or more Saturdays to compensate the loss of working days. Attendance on all such Saturdays is mandatory.
9. Every student must take part in the school games and other activities, unless found physically unwell or exempted by the Principal for specific reason.
10. Please note that students will not be allowed to go home for lunch. Parents should make necessary arrangements to send lunch to the school before 11.40 am.
11. Parents should not contact any teacher via telephone or at their residence. Parents are requested to meet the teacher only in the school premises.
12. Without any prior permission from school authorities no students are allowed to collect funds in cash or cheque from any internal and external source. Parents are expected to advise their wards in this

regard. "Any violation shall result in dismissal with a T.C. issued".

13. Students are forbidden from bringing heavy cash / cellphone and wearing costly jewels to school. However, if they have to bring money for bus /auto etc., it is allowed. If any student is found carrying a large amount of cash during surprise checks, the money and cellphone will be confiscated.
14. The school office will accept school fees, van fees, or any other payments only from parents or guardians directly via online transfer, card payment, etc.

DISCIPLINE AND CODE OF CONDUCT

- Gentle behavior, cleanliness, regularity and punctuality are stressed by way of discipline.
- Defacing the walls, floors, desks, black boards, toilet etc., are strictly prohibited and liability will be ascribed as decided in case of violation.
- School uniform should be worn on all working days and for all functions. Students without proper uniform will not be allowed to enter the school campus.
- During rainy days and winter seasons students are permitted to wear sweaters.
- The uniform must be neat and clean. Parents must ensure that they send their ward in a proper and complete uniform. If there is any irregularity in the uniform, parents should send a letter to the concerned teacher. In case anything is lost at school, it will be provided as soon as it is available.
- Irregular attendance, use of profane language, or actions, insubordination to teachers, cheating or any other misconduct deemed objectionable by the school are sufficient reasons for the dismissal of student.
- Parents must take responsibility for checking their ward's bag to ensure that they bring books and

notebooks according to the timetable and do not carry unwanted items like pen drives, CDs, or iPods to school.

- Students should safeguard their personal belongings such as books, tiffin boxes etc., Management will not be responsible for any loss / damage.
- **Students should not bring cell phones or any other electronic gadgets without prior permission to school.**
- Ragging and bullying (hurting emotionally) are banned in the educational institutions. Any student indulging in such activities, will face stringent action as per the established rules and regulations.
- Parents must understand that an educational institution has its own set of rules and responsibilities, which differ from those of other workplaces. As such, everyone should understand its spirit and is requested to obey the rules and respect the accredited systems.
- It has been observed that, on many occasions, parents insist on meeting the authorities directly. There is a proper procedure and system in place for addressing their queries. Any complaint may be brought to the grievance cell for resolution.
